



Tea light holder

Supplies

- LED battery tea light (do not use open flame!), approx 4 cm/1.5 IN in diameter
- Yarn: Scheepjes Catona, approx 25 m/27 yd
- Hook 3.0 mm
- Stitch marker (or a small piece of yarn)
- Darning needle for weaving in ends
- Scissors

Abbreviations (US terms)

st	stitch	bphdc	back post half double
MR	magic ring		crochet
sl st	slip stitch	dc	double crochet
ch	chain	bpdc	back post double crochet
ch sp	chain space	picot	<i>ch 3, sl st in the first ch</i>
sc	single crochet	BL	back loop
bpsc	back post single crochet	FL	front loop
bpsc2tog	back post single crochet 2 together	[-]	work in the same st/ch sp

hdc	half double crochet		

Rounds 1 – 10 are worked in continuous rounds. Use a stitch marker to keep track of where the rounds start.

Round 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each st (12 sc)

Round 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (18 sc)

Round 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (24 sc)

Round 5: *3 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (30 sc)

Round 6: *in BL*, 1 sc in each st (30 sc)

Rounds 7-9: 1 sc (in both loops) in each st (30 sc)

Round 10: *in BL*, 1 sl st in each st (30 sl st)

Fasten off.



Rounds 11-14: join each round with a sl st to the first st. Make sure that the opening of the light holder is facing you.

Round 11: *The round is worked in FL of round 6. Start in any st, *1 sl st, ch 3, skip 2 st* (10 sl st, 10 ch sp)*

Round 12: *The first dc of the round is replaced by ch 3. Sl st in ch sp, * [4 dc, ch 3, 4 dc] in ch sp, 1 sc in the next ch sp* (40 dc, 5 sc, 5 ch sp)*

Round 13: *ch 1 (do not count as a st), *2 sc, 2 hdc, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in ch sp, 2 hdc, 2 sc, skip sc* (20 sc, 20 hdc, 20 dc, 5 ch sp)*

Round 14: *sl st to the 2nd sc, ch 1 (do not count as a st), *1 bpdc, 3 bphdc, 1 bpdc, [1 dc, picot, 1 dc] in ch sp, 1 bpdc, 3 bphdc, 1 bpdc, bpdc2tog over the next 2 st* (10 bpdc, 30 bphdc, 10 bpdc, 10 dc, 5 picot, 5 x bpdc2tog)*

Fasten off. Weave in the ends. Block your work for best results.
